

# Stainless Steel Weep Hole Covers



## Rid-O-Mice Installation

Providing the perfect protection from pests entering weep holes, while maintaining wall ventilation. Decorates the facade.

Rid-O-Mice is easily installed inside the weep hole. It fits into spaces 5mm to 25 mm wide. It can also be cut to modify height. Be sure to clean weep hole of debris and dirt and remove any excess mortar so you are left with a large smooth hole.

Hold device between your fingers. Pinch ends of device toward each other.

Slide cover into weep hole and push in until flush with wall.

If weep hole 1/4 to less than 1/2 inch taller than cover, center cover top and bottom in hole so upper and lower gap is less than 1/4 inch.



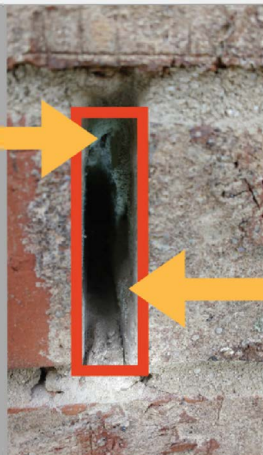

Depending on the width of the weep hole the shape visible area can change in pitch. For very narrow weep holes you may need to use a block of wood and hammer to push the grill into place.

Rid-o-Mice is properly placed when the front of the grill is in line with the surface of the brick. This means the grill is firmly wedged into the facade.

Trash Mortar

Not all weep holes are clean. This is dependant upon the brick layer and affects a small percentage of homes

If you have trash mortar remove it with a mortar drill. (bit not to exceed depth of brick, wear safety gloves and goggles)

Only clear the amount needed to allow the cover to slide in.
